City of Kittitas Council Meeting Special Session Minutes August 2, 2006

The Special Session Meeting of the Kittitas City Council began at 7:00 p.m., August 2, 2006, at the New Life Assembly Church. Mayor Cousart along with council members Helland, Simpson, Gay, Gilmour, and Huber were present.

Staff present was Clerk/Treasurer Newcomb.

The hiring committee for Chief of Police interviewed Mike Studer who currently is employed at Central Washington University and was pleased with the results. Councilmember Simpson moved to approve hiring Mike Studer as the City of Kittitas Chief of Police as a non-union salaried position starting at \$4,200 per month. Councilmember Helland seconded the motion. The motion passed with 4 yes and Councilmember Gilmour no.

Councilmember Helland moved to approve hiring Temporary Reserve Officer Andy Bayne at \$13.19 per hour. As a Temporary Reserve Officer he is allowed to work a maximum of 35 hours per week or 151.67 hours per month. Councilmember Simpson seconded the motion. The motion passed 5 yes and 0 no.

Councilmember Helland moved to adjourn the August 2, 2006, meeting. Councilmember Simpson seconded the motion. The meeting was adjourned at 7:40 p.m.
