## City of Kittitas Council Meeting Minutes January 16, 2009

Councilmember Turpin called the meeting of the Kittitas City Council to order at 4:00 p.m., January 16, 2009. Councilmembers present; Gilmour, Turpin, Gay, Alvord, and Camarata.

Councilmember Turpin led those assembled in the Flag Salute.

Councilmember Turpin questioned how the meeting was advertised and requested to cancel and re-schedule it. Councilmember Alvord explained we are not required to give 24 hours notice to newspapers unless we have the request in writing from them. The notice faxed to them is informational only. The meetings are properly advertised by posting them on the reader board and in city hall with 24 hours notice. Councilmember Alvord moved to continue the meeting and Councilmember Gay seconded the motion. The motion passed 3 yes and Councilmember Turpin and Gilmour voting no.

Pro Tem Mayor Gay took over the meeting.

## **Mayor Election/Oath of Office**

Per the city attorney, the election held for mayor on January 13, 2009, is invalid as per the open public meetings act as council must vote by a show of hands. Council voted as follows:

Fred Huber – Councilmember Alvord, Gay, and Camarata Sean Turpin – Councilmember Gilmour and Turpin

Pro Tem Mayor Gay had the new mayor, Fred Huber, sworn into office.

## Kittitas County Sheriff's Office Interlocal Agreement

Council agreed to have the following services included in the sheriff's interlocal agreement: assistance with evidence, gun license checks (nics), and provide patrol when our officers are off duty. Councilmember Gay moved to approve the interlocal agreement for \$1,000 per month or 25%, whichever is less, of the 3/10's revenue, and Councilmember Alvord seconded the motion. The motion passed 5 yes and 0 no.

Councilmember Gay moved to adjourn the meeting and Councilmember Camarata seconded the motion. The motion passed 5 yes and 0 no. The meeting adjourned at 4:45 p.m.
