REPORT OF OFFICERS AND SPECIAL GUESTS

A. Staff Reports (informational only)

Debbie Lee – Clerk/Treasurer

• Debbie Lee informed Council that Gray & Osborne will be at the next Council Meeting with an Engineering Agreement for a load rating on the Bader Pocket Bridge. WSDOT is requiring all bridges over 20 feet and under 200 feet to be analyzed for a newer type of truck. Basically it is a short truck that carries more weight, but spread out on more axels. This type of truck allows more total weight to be on the bridge at one time. There are currently no particular funding programs that can pay for this analysis. It is transportation related work that the TBD can fund. The ramification of not completing this report and getting it to WSDOT would jeopardize the STBG funds that the City has for the East 1st Avenue Project. Gray and Osborne have experience completing these calculations at a cost of \$4,000-\$5,000.

C. Bond Counsel Confirmation of Engagement Water Revenue Bond and Interim Financing USDA (waterline replacement 1^{st} , 2^{nd} and 3^{rd})

- The "requirement" for a bond counsel in governmental loans goes back more than 100 years and arises because of the unique nature of governmental loans. Unlike private citizens who are able to borrow money and agree to terms (assuming that they are competent (e.g. of age) with lending institutions, governmental entities are constrained by state law.
- State law limitations are intended to protect the local taxpayers.
- Local governments may borrow money only in strict compliance with state law. If a local government does not comply with state law, the loan is invalid, and the lender is able to be repaid by the governmental entity. As a result, lenders routinely require an opinion from a recognized law firm, experienced in local government lending, to the effect that the loan is a valid and binding obligation of the local jurisdiction (e.g. the City) thus, the bond counsel is a law firm that specializes in the state law applicable to local government borrowing transactions.

- Bond counsel provides an opinion to the City as well as the lender that all requirements of state law have been satisfied in connection with the loan.
- Fees typically are on a fixed fee basis, payable from loan proceeds and are payable only if the loan is closed.

MOTION: Councilmember Whitford made a motion to accept the letter of engagement for the Water Revenue Bond and Interim Financing (USDA) \$799,000 from K&L Gates; second by Councilmember Beard.

- Councilmember Smith would like to find someone who could water the planters on a regular basis.

- Councilmember Smith also thanked Councilmember Beard for working so hard on the Events Committee.
- Councilmember Whitford said the water trailer is slow but can be used or fill containers to water the planters. It would be nice to have a mapped area of the planters.
- Councilmember Coleman said there is an easy place to fill the water tank out at Exit 115, Steve Hart allows the City to use this.
